Give three amalgamations showing the change of direction with 1-1/2 turn to L; 2-3/8 turn to L; 3-1/2 turn to L. A requested amalgamation needs to include a precede and a follow.

Why is step 6 NOT a 'conclusion step' in the foxtrot or quickstep natural turn?

What is a common error in the impetus, the change of direction, the heel pull?

How would you count the lady's part to the impetus turn? To the natural spin turn?
